

**PUBLIC NOTICE
NOTICE OF INTENT TO FILE**

Please take notice that the City of Old Town, 365 Maine Street, Old Town, ME 04468 (207) 827-7175 is intending to file a Natural Resources Protection Act permit application with the Maine Department of Environmental Protection pursuant to the provisions of 38 MRSA §§ 480-A thru 480-HH on or about June 19, 2020. The application is for the dredging of two sections along the Backwaters of the Penobscot River at the Old Town Municipal Airport Seaplane Base and the Maine Forestry Service Seaplane Ramp.

A request for a public hearing or a request that the Board of Environmental Protection assume jurisdiction over this application must be received by the Department, in writing, no later than 20 days after the application is found by the Department to be complete and is accepted for processing. A public hearing may or may not be held at the discretion of the Commissioner or Board of Environmental Protection. Public comment on the application will be accepted throughout the processing of the application.

The application will be filed for public inspection at the Department of Environmental Protection's office in Bangor during normal working hours. A copy of the application may also be seen at the municipal office in Old Town, Maine.
