Sealed bids for Cemetery Improvements for the Lawndale and St. Joseph Cemeteries will be received by the **Public Works Director at the Public Works Garage, 73 Airport Road, Old Town, Maine, until March 24th at 11:00 a.m.** local time, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids submitted after this time will not be accepted. Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope clearly marked **“Groundwater Drainage Improvements for the Lawndale Cemetery & St. Josephs Cemetery”**.

The proposed work may include, but is not necessarily limited to: The installation of underdrain piping, drainage structures, and drainage piping to include excavation, installation of these materials, as well as other ancillary items.
