Commercial Users
Effective July 1, 2006

Fees must be paid in advance at City Hall

MUST HAVE STICKER TO ENTER RECYCLING CENTER

Dump Sticker	\$30.00	
Every Cubic Yard	\$30.00	8' bed = 2 cubic yards 6 1/2 ' bed = 1.5 cubic yards

1 yard is minimum charge, no half yards

OTHER COSTS:

White goods: \$10.00 each. Includes but not limited to: stoves, refrigerators, freezers, dishwashers, washers & dryers, small motorized equipment (i.e. lawnmowers, snow blowers), metal microwaves, air conditioners, computer towers, furnace, 55 gallon drums must have the top cut off, 275 gallon drums must be cut in half and are \$10.00 per half.

Universal waste:

NOTE: All refrigerators/freezers must have the doors removed.

Tires: MUST HAVE RIMS REMOVED!! (rims will be taken as scrap metal)

Up to 20"	\$ 2.00
20 - 22"	\$10.00
Heavy Equipment above 22"	\$50.00

TV/CRT up to 25"	\$12.00
Above 25"	\$30.00

Pure used motor oil and kerosene: used in our waste furnace at the recycling center, no fee

Propane tanks:

Up to 20#	\$2.00
20 – 100#	\$10.00

NOT ALLOWED AT OUR SITE

Household Hazardous Waste: antifreeze, gasoline, paint thinner, turpentine, oil based paint fertilizer, pesticides

Latex paint cans: open and dry out and put with curbside trash

Rechargeable batteries: Ni-Cad and NI-NH may be taken to Radio Shack. (not alkaline)
