

Old Town Recycle Center Fees

Residential Users

Effective July 1, 2006

**Fees must be paid in advance at City Hall**

**Dump Sticker-**: \$20.00                      8' bed = 2 cubic yards                      6 1/2' bed = 1.5 cubic yards  
1 yard is minimum charge. no half yards

**White goods/Metal**: \$10.00 each. Includes but not limited to stoves, refrigerators, freezers, dishwashers, washers, dryers, small motorized equipment (i.e. lawnmowers, snow blowers), metal microwaves, air conditioners, computer towers with components, 55 gallon drums must have the top cut off, furnaces, 275 gallon drum must be cut in half and are \$10 per half.

**NOTE: All refrigerators/freezers must have the doors removed!!!**

Scrap metal, including metal doors, bicycles with the tires removed, empty computer cases, folding chairs, items smaller than 2' x 4' sheets will be accepted FREE

**Tires: MUST HAVE RIMS REMOVED!!** (rims will be taken as scrap metal)

Pure used motor oil and kerosene: FREE

Fluorescent bulbs and ballasts: FREE

**Wood/Boards** (not pressure treated) \$2 00 cubic yard

Includes but not limited to kitchen tables, kitchen chairs, small ,wooden desks, wooden shelving

**Brush:** No Charge

**Demolition:** \$2 00 per cubic yard for the first trip per week  
\$30.00 every cubic yard thereafter if in same week

Includes: piaster, mortar, bricks, building blocks, roofing material, sheetrock, plastics, ceramic fixtures, pressure treated wood, anything fiberglass, big plastic toys, swimming pool, rugs (carpets cut up 4' x 4' or smaller can be left curbside), tub surrounds
